APPROVAL OF MINUTES Commissioner Maridel Wittmer made a motion to approve the minutes from the

MEETING motion. The motion carried 4 – 0.

followed. There was no motion to approve the resolution.

COMMISSIONER OF Mayor Cody Bletscher asked Assistant City Attorney Luke Sunderland to  
STREETS – VACANCY explain to the Commission the process of filling the vacant position for  
Commissioner of Streets. The mayor presented four names for consideration;  
Trevin Edelman, Megan Bunck, Sharon Kibbe and Austin Wasinger. Mayor  
Bletscher asked each candidate in attendance to address the Commission. Bunck,  
Edelman and Wasinger were in attendance and addressed the Commission.  
Sharon Kibbe had provided each Commissioner with a written statement  
beforehand. Discussion followed. Mayor Bletscher asked each Commissioner to  
write the name of the candidate on a piece of paper. After counting the votes, with  
Kibbe receiving two votes, Bunck receiving one vote and Edelman receiving one  
vote. Mayor Bletscher asked if any of the Commissioners wanted to change their  
vote. No Commissioner wanted to change the vote. Therefore, the Assistant City  
Attorney Luke Sunderland would then make the selection because there was no  
majority vote. Sunderland then appointed Trevin Edelman. Discussion followed.
