ARTICLE 1. CITY ELECTIONS

6-101. TERMS. (a) The mayor and commissioners shall be elected for four years; and at each election thereafter such officers shall be elected for terms of four years, and shall hold their offices until their successors are elected and qualified. The mayor and four commissioners shall constitute the board of commissioners of the city, and the mayor shall be the presiding officer of the board. Mayors and commissioners elected in the year 1967 shall have terms expiring in 1971. Mayors and commissioners elected in the year 1968 shall have terms expiring in 1973.

(b) The regular term of the commissioner of streets and commissioner of parks and recreation shall be for four years commencing with the city election in April, 1983, and at each election thereafter the commissioner of streets and commissioner of parks and recreation shall be elected for terms of four years, shall hold their offices until their successors are elected and qualified.

ARTICLE 2. WARDS

6-201. DIVISION OF WARDS. The city shall be divided into four wards, to be numbered Ward 1, Ward 2, Ward 3, and Ward 4, with the boundary lines as follows:

(a) Ward 1, beginning at the most easterly city limits at a point that would be an extension of the center line of Main Street, proceeding west to the center line of Washington Avenue, then south on an extension of the center line of Washington Avenue to the south city limits, then following the city limit boundary to the east and north to the point of beginning.

(b) Ward 2, beginning at the center of the intersection of Main Street and Washington Avenue, proceeding west on an extension of the center line of Main Street to the west city limits, then following the city limit boundary to the south and east to a point on an extension of the center line of Washington Avenue, then north on the center line of Washington Avenue to the point of beginning.

(c) Ward 3, beginning at the center of the intersection of Main Street and Washington Avenue, proceeding west on an extension of the center line of Main Street to the west city limits, then following the city limit boundary to the north and east to a point on an extension of the center line of Washington Avenue, then south on the center line of Washington Avenue to the point of beginning.

(d) Ward 4, beginning at the most easterly city limits at a point that would be an extension of the center line of Main Street, proceeding west to

ORDINANCE _____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING IN PART PORTIONS OF THE CURRENT CODE OF THE CITY OF SABETHA, KANSAS, REGULATING AND ESTABLISHING THE DIVISION OF THE CITY INTO WARDS FOR ELECTIONS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF SABETHA, KANSAS.

Be it ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Sabetha, Kansas:

Section 1. That Section 6-201, Chapter VI, Article 2. of the Code of the City of Sabetha is hereby repealed and the following adopted in its place and stead, including any other provisions of said City Code which are inconsistent with the provisions herein.

Section 2. That Section 6-201 of the Code of the City of Sabetha shall read as follows:

Section 6-201. DIVISION OF WARDS. The City shall be divided into three wards, to be numbered Ward 1, Ward 2, and Ward 3, with the boundary lines as follows:

(a) Ward 1, All of that property located within the city limits of the City of Sabetha located south of the center line of Main Street, to include any property located within the boundary of the City of Sabetha located south of a line extending easterly and westerly of the center line of Main Street as currently platted.

(b) Ward 2, All of that property located within the city limits of the City of Sabetha located north of the center line of Main Street, to include any property located within the boundary of the City of Sabetha located north of a line extending easterly and westerly of the center line of Main Street as currently platted, except for that property annexed into the City of Sabetha under Ordinance #2003-1383.

(c) Ward 3, all of the property annexed into the City of Sabetha pursuant to Ordinance #2003-1383.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication once in the official city newspaper.
