

ORDINANCE NO. 1517

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE #1496 AND ESTABLISHING RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR ELECTRICITY SOLD FROM THE MUNICIPAL ELECTRICAL SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF SABETHA AND REPEALING ANY PORTION OF ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF WHICH MAY BE IN CONFLICT HEREWITH, AND PROVIDING FOR A FUEL COST COMPUTATION FORMULA FOR RATES CHARGED HEREUNDER.

Be It Ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Sabetha, Kansas, as follows:

Section 1. For all bills rendered on and after September 30, 2015 for electric power sold from the municipal electric system of the City of Sabetha, Kansas, the rates for all patrons of the municipal electric system of the City of Sabetha, Kansas as well as the fuel cost computation formula shall be as follows:

A. RESIDENTIAL - Corporate Limits

AVAILABILITY:

Available for residential service through one meter to single-occupancy dwelling units for all domestic household and ordinary farm use.

MONTHLY RATE:

Monthly customer charge of \$7.50

All KWH at \$0.0877 per KWH

FUEL ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE:

All energy sold under this schedule shall be subject to a fuel cost adjustment as set forth in FAC-08.

WINTER SEASON HEATING RATE:

If customer permanently installs and uses as the primary source of heat two (2) KW or more of electric space heating equipment and so informs the city in writing, then in calculating the monthly charges during the heating season, a block of 1000 KWH will be classified as space heating for which the customer will be charged \$0.0777 per KWH. The heating season shall begin after the September meter reading and continue through the April meter reading. This block will begin after 1000 KWH of usage in a month.

MINIMUM BILLS:

Minimum bills do not include the applicable fuel adjustment. The minimum monthly bills shall be \$7.50.

B. COMMERCIAL – Corporate Limits

AVAILABILITY:

Available to Consumers who do not meet the requirements of the availability and character of service clauses of the residential rate, who desire multiphase service or whose metered load does not exceed 75 KW of demand.

MONTHLY RATE:

Monthly customer charge of \$10.00

All KWH at \$0.0896 per KWH

FUEL ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE:

All energy sold under this schedule shall be subject to a fuel cost adjustment as set forth in FAC-08.

MINIMUM BILL:

Minimum bills do not include the applicable fuel adjustment. The minimum monthly bill shall be \$10.00

C. LARGE POWER – Corporate Limits

AVAILABILITY:

Consumers whose metered load at any time exceeds 75 kilowatts of demand must be on LARGE POWER. Consumers whose metered load at any time exceeds 25 but is less than 75 kilowatt of demand may select between COMMERCIAL and LARGE POWER. Consumer must stay selected rate for one year.

MONTHLY RATE:

Monthly customer charge of \$10.00

DEMAND CHARGE:

\$6.81 per KW of billing demand

ENERGY CHARGE:

All KWH at \$0.0542 per KWH

FUEL ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE:

All energy sold under this schedule shall be subject to a fuel cost adjustment as set forth in FAC-08.

MINIMUM BILL:

Minimum bills do not include the applicable fuel adjustment. The minimum monthly bill shall be the highest of the following.

- (1) \$6.81 per KW of the current monthly billing demand
- (2) \$6.81 per KW of the highest monthly billing demand registered in any of the preceding eleven (11) months.
- (3) \$150.00

DETERMINATION OF BILLING DEMAND:

The metered demand is based on the maximum fifteen-minute demand, as registered by a demand meter. The demand will be determined by the KW of the demand registered in the months of May through September. The metered demand (KW) shall be adjusted where the customer's power factor falls below 85%. The adjusted billing demand shall be determined by dividing 85% by the monthly power factor percentage metered, and multiplying the result by the monthly metered demand.

D. RESIDENTIAL – RURAL AVAILABILITY:

Available for residential service through one meter to single-occupancy dwelling units for all domestic household and ordinary farm use.

MONTHLY RATE:

Monthly customer charge of \$7.50

All KWH at \$0.0877 per KWH

FUEL ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE:

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WINTER SEASON HEATING RATE:

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MINIMUM BILLS:

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E. COMMERCIAL – RURAL AVAILABILITY:

Available to customers who do not meet the requirements of the availability and character of service clauses of the residential rate, who desire multiphase service or whose metered load does not exceed 75 KW.

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F. LARGE POWER - RURAL AVAILABILITY:

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G. PAYMENT

Monthly bills will be rendered NET, payable within fifteen days of the date of the bill, and will become delinquent thereafter. Ten percent shall be added to the net amount on the date the bill becomes delinquent as stated thereon.

H. FUEL COST COMPUTATION FORMULA SHALL BE AS FOLLOWS (FAC-95)

The rates for energy to which this adjustment is applicable shall be increased or decreased by \$0.00001 per kilowatt-hour-hour (KWH) for each \$0.00001 (or major fraction hereof) increase or decrease in the aggregate cost of energy per KWH as computed by the following formula:

$$[(G + P + O) / (S / L)] - B = \text{Adjustment}$$

WHERE

- G = The latest 12-month actual total cost of power generated.
- P = The latest 12-month actual total purchased power cost.
- O = The latest 12-month actual total cost of any other associated power supply expenses.
- S = The latest 12-month actual total KWH generated and purchased.
- L = The Loss calculation will be based on the distribution system losses. This percentage may change from time to time based on changes to the loss calculation.
- B = The base cost of power supply included in retail rates.
- B for the March 2017 ECA = \$0.03840/KWH
- B for the April 2017 ECA = \$0.03797/KWH
- B for the May 2017 ECA = \$0.03754/KWH
- B for the June 2017 ECA = \$0.03711/KWH
- B for the July 2017 ECA = \$0.03668/KWH
- B for the August 2017 ECA = \$0.03625/KWH
- B for the September 2017 ECA = \$0.03582/KWH
- B for the October 2017 ECA = \$0.03539/KWH
- B for the November 2017 ECA and subsequent months = \$0.03501/KWH

Section 2. All other ordinances or parts thereof that may be in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.


Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its publication in the official City newspaper as provided by law.
