Pledge of Allegiance

At 6:00 p.m. Mayor Doug Clark opened the hearing on the Amended State Budget for public comments. There were no public comments. Mayor Doug Clark closed the hearing at 6:01 p.m.

Approved the minutes from the November 25, 2019 Commission meeting.

AMBULANCE PURCHASE Doug Brammer, EMS Director, appeared before the Commission to discuss purchase of a new ambulance. Discussion followed. Commission Norman Schmitt, Jr. made a motion to approve Option 1 from Osage Industries, Inc. at a cost of \$212,000. Commissioner Nick Aberle seconded the motion. The motion carried 5 – 0.

POLICE REPORT Police Chief Robert Wahwasuck was in attendance to provide an update of activities of the Police Department. Discussion followed. No action was taken.

STATE BUDGET AMENDMENT Commissioner Norman Schmitt, Jr. made a motion to approve the 2019 Amended State Budget. Commissioner Maridel Wittmer seconded the motion. The motion carried 5 – 0.

MID-TOWN BUILDING Mayor Doug Clark informed the Commission and Citizens present that he had received comments from Citizens concerning the closing and demolition of the Mid-Town Building. Discussion followed. Commissioner Nick Aberle made a motion to have a public hearing at the January 13th, 2020 Commission meeting to provide time for citizens to express their feelings toward the future of the Mid-Town building. Commissioner Maridel Wittmer seconded the motion. The motion carried 5 – 0.

HOLIDAY SCHEDULE City Administrator Douglas Allen informed the Commission that the Holiday schedule for the Christmas and New Years Holiday for non-essential personnel. Employees will have a half-day on December 24th, all day on December 25th, and January 1, 2020.
