HOSPTIAL LAND PURCHASE

Dr. Longabaugh gave an update on the current project as well as a history of the Hospital and the City cooperation with the existing land owned by the City and leased to the Hospital. Dr Longabaugh proposed that the Sabetha Community Hospital would like to purchase the land on which the Hospital sits, excluding the Wellness Center property. The proposed purchase price would be \$1,513,800.0 with the payments remaining at \$13,050.00 monthly as the current agreement sets forth. Discussion followed.
